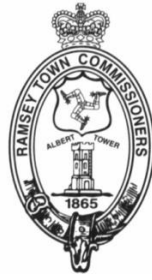

**Your request – FOI037**

We write further to your request which was received on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2023 and which states:

*“1) How many fines have been issued under the litter act for:*

*a. Commercial Operators*

*b. Private individuals*

*2) How many warnings have been given for the offences covered under the same act for a.*

*Commercial Operators b. Private individuals*

*3) For anyone given a warning how many have subsequently been issued a fine for a. Commercial Operators b. Private individuals”*

**Response to your request**

The information you have requested is shown in **BOLD** below:

*1) How many fines have been issued under the litter act for:*

*a. Commercial Operators **11 (ELEVEN)***

*b. Private individuals **12 (TWELVE)***

2) How many warnings have been given for the offences covered under the same act for

a. Commercial Operators **34 (THIRTY FOUR)**

b. Private individuals **52 (FIFTY TWO)**

3) For anyone given a warning how many have subsequently been issued a fine for

a. Commercial Operators **7 (SEVEN)**

b. Private individuals **0 (ZERO)**

This covers all “warnings” issued. In some cases, where it is not possible to identify who has caused the offence, we will have communicated with all the occupiers of a property/properties resulting in multiple “warnings” for a single offence.

### Your right to request a review

If you are unhappy with this response to your Freedom of Information request, you may ask us to carry out an internal review of the response, by completing a complaint form and submitting it electronically or by delivery/post to the sender of this letter at the address / email address shown.

If you would like a paper version of the complaint form to be sent to you by post, please contact us and we will be happy to arrange for this. Your review request should explain why you are dissatisfied with this response and should be made as soon as practicable. We will respond as soon as the review has been concluded.

If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, you then have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner for a decision on;

1. Whether we have responded to your request for information in accordance with Part 2 of the Freedom of Information Act; or
2. Whether we are justified in refusing to give you the information requested.

In response to an application for review, the Information Commissioner may, at any time, attempt to resolve a matter by negotiation, conciliation, mediation or another form of alternative dispute resolution and will have regard to any outcome of this in making any subsequent decision.
